Assessments and Evaluations:

The students will be assessed and evaluated throughout the year based on traditional tests, quizzes, observations, performance, projects, in class assignments and homework. Grades are determined in the following ways:

<u>English</u> Classwork – 60% Homework – 15% Tests – 25%	<u>Religion</u> Classwork – 60% Homework – 15% Tests – 25%
<u>Spelling/Phonics</u> Classwork/Homework – 40% Tests – 60%	<u>Science</u> Classwork/Homework – 60% Tests/Projects – 40%
<u>Social Studies</u> Classwork/Homework – 60% Tests/Projects – 40%	<u>Reading</u> Classwork – 60% Homework – 15% Tests – 25%
<u>Math</u> Classwork – 50% Homework – 10% Tests – 40%	

Graded tests and assignments will be sent home for your review. If your child receives a failing grade (69% or below) on a test or assignment please have your child return the paper with your signature or initials after you have reviewed the mistakes with him/her.

4. Conference with Principal


Homework Policy

Homework will be assigned daily except on Fridays. Students are responsible for writing their homework assignment and parents should initial homework log when homework is complete. Students are expected to complete the homework assignment each night and return it to school the following day. If homework is not completed, the student will complete it and turn it in by the next school day. For every day that the homework is late two (2) points will be taken off the final grade of the assignment. If homework is being missed consistently it will greatly affect your child's grade.
